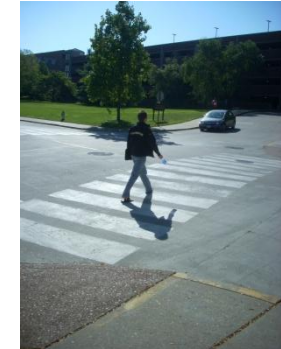


Funding Sources for Livable Streets

The following are possible funding sources for livable streets elements cited below. Livable Street Element	Funding Sources*
Bicycle and pedestrian plan	STP, PLA, TCSP, CDBG
Bicycle lanes on roadway	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, FTA, TE, BRI, FLH, BYW, CDBG, USDA
Bicycle parking facilities	STP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, FTA, TE, BYW
Bicycle/pedestrian maps	STP, SRTS, CMAQ, 402
Bicycle racks on buses	STP, TEA, CMAQ, FTA, TE
Bicycle storage or service facility	STP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, FTA, TE, BRI, TCSP, JOBS
Curb cuts and ramps	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, USDA
Paved shoulders	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, BRI, FLH, BYW, CDBG
Shared use path/trail	NHS, STP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, RTP, BRI, FLH, BYW, TD
Sidewalks, new or retrofit	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, FTA, TE, BRI, FLH, BYW, CDBG, USDA
Signal improvements	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ
Signed bike route	NHS, STP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, FLH, BYW, TD
Traffic calming	STP, HSIP, SRTS, TCSP, CID, USDA
Trail/Highway Intersection	NHS, STP, HSIP, SRTS, TEA, CMAQ, RTP, FLH, BYW
